In 2019, Seva Food Bank became a client of DoGood Funding. The charity's visionary founder and Board Chair, Kulvir Singh Gill, met with DoGood staff and explained that grants were a challenge to access for the organization over the years. DoGood was hired to help Seva raise funds from corporations, foundations, and governments.

Over the next six years, DoGood helped Seva endure a pandemic, keep its shelves stocked, and keep its staff paid.

In total, \$1,033,000 (estimate) has been raised for the largest food bank in Mississauga since DoGood was engaged!



In 2023, in response to a new fund released by the regional government, DoGood brought in a consulting partner specializing in social enterprise. A grant proposal for \$150,000 (estimated) per year for up to two years was successfully secured by the firm.

Seva was able to expand its footprint to Brampton, Ontario – a new service area. Today, the food bank has successfully received funding to expand its HVAC filtration capacity at its Malton (Mississauga) warehouse location, as well as successful grants for operations, and digital marketing campaigns.
